The vastness of nursing roles at Austin Health's Mental Health Division provides you with opportunities in the following areas and positions:

- Acute inpatient services across all age ranges; child, youth, adult, aged, and specialty practice including peri infant, neuropsychiatry, eating disorders, psychological trauma recovery and secure extended care
- Crisis Assessment and Treatment Team, including Youth Crisis Assessment and Treatment Team

- PACER – experienced mental health clinicians working in the community alongside the Victoria Police
